Summary of Final Report of out 2016-17 Trustland Plan

Goal 1: Canyon Elementary will have 80% of our students reading on grade level and proficient in the areas of Reading and Math by providing interventions and professional development and support for teaching staff.

Here were the results of our Measurement areas in reaching our goal for our students to read on grade level. Comparing beginning of year to end of year.

Dibels:

1st Grade BOY (2016): 68% on Grade Level EOY (2017): 68%. 64% made typical or above typical growth. On Grade Level Growth +/- 0%.

2nd Grade BOY (2016): 86% on Grade Level EOY (2017): 71%. 62% made typical or above typical growth. Grade Level Growth +/- 15%.

3rd Grade BOY (2016): 77%. on Grade Level EOY (2017): 81%. 78% made typical or above typical growth. Grade Level Growth +/- 4%.

District Benchmarks:

1st Grade BOY: 78%, EOY: 73% Growth: +/- 5%

2nd Grade BOY: 61%, EOY: 73% Growth: +/- 12%

3rd Grade BOY: 69%, EOY: 74% Growth: +/- 5%

SAGE End of Level Testing Proficiency:

3rd Grade LA: 59% 3rd Grade MA: 58%

The action steps were achieved as follows:

1. Literacy Intervention Software Imagine Learning was provided for K-2. SuccessMaker and Waterford was continued for grades 1-4.

2. Technicians were hired: Take Home Library (1)-Literacy; LLI Technicians- (2) Literacy; Math/Reading Comp. Tech (1). Collaboration days were provided for K-6 (4 days); 3rd and 6th Grades (Summer Collaboration); Team Leaders (1 day). Conferences provided for Leadership in 21st Century 4 teachers; Art Conference (USU Summer) 3 teachers; UCET (Technology) 2 teachers. Classroom substitutes were provided for Literacy Collaboration and Curriculum Collaboration Days and substitutes were provided for 2 days for all grade levels K-6.

Action Plan steps were completed.

Goal 2: Technology will be used across content areas to enhance instruction for students at Canyon Elementary. Will upgrade and replace existing (aging) classroom technology projectors, document cameras, and audio enhancement systems. Address need to lower computer to student ratios through (mini chrome book labs or other alternatives). Provide teachers with access to technology tools to enhance instruction of curriculum.

The following measurement data was achieved.

We were able to purchase additional classroom chromebooks (upper grades) and ipads (lower grades). Our student to computer ratio has lowered it is now approx. 4 students to 1 device/computer. We purchased 2 classroom audio enhancement systems, literacy user licensing for Accelerated Reader for our 4th and 5th grade students (200 students), and one classroom document camera.

Action steps were addressed as follows:

1. We increased the number of classroom chromebooks, ipads.
2. We maintained and updated existing technology this year replacing 1 document camera.
3. We updated/replaced two existing audio enhancement systems.

Action Plan steps were completed.

We followed and were in compliance with all directives regarding elections, Council meetings, and posting of information.

The data and actions support the positive influence and impact our Trustland expenditures make in the areas of academic needs for our students.
