- 3. Nebo District Accreditation Review
 - *Julie Peery then shared the Nebo Accreditation Review video and powerpoint from the district. Nebo is going through an accreditation process and will be gathering evidence regarding four areas: Culture of Learning, Leadership of Learning, Engagement of Learning and Growth in Learning. Each school administrator has created links to documentation of their practices in each of the four areas. Also, someone from Cognia, the accreditation team coming to Nebo, may contact teachers and parents as members of SCC to ask about their school. Julie made SCC parents aware of that possibility.
- 4. New and additional ways of meeting the literacy needs of students
 - *A discussion was held about the additional things being done this year to improve literacy instruction and especially for those with learning gaps. Mrs. Peery showed a video of Mrs. Cranmer, our ESSER teacher, doing small group intention phonics and phonemic awareness instruction. Students were identified to receive this intervention this year to help them improve with their reading. Also, seven instructional technicians were hired to work with small groups of students both in literacy and math. Mrs. Peery also showed a quick video of students using Amira, a new online program that uses AI to listen to students read and give feedback. This program is used alternately with IReady reading in each classroom. A couple questions that arose were: Is the certified teacher going to be able to continue doing ESSER instruction next year and the answer is that Mrs. Peery doesn't know yet. The ESSER federal funds will end in 2024 so if that program continues, most likely a different revenue flow will need to provide funding for it. Also, it was mentioned that it would be helpful for parents to know some of the basic reading skills their children should have and may be working on in intervention groups...basic things like the difference between phonemic awareness skills and phonics skills. Mrs. Peery asked what format would be best...either a parent literacy night or something simple like a "tips" sheet regarding the reading skills children are learning at school. They agreed that a paper going home would be most effective and possibly a parent night later in the year or future. Mrs. Peery will discuss that with Mrs. Cranmer and the Instructional Leadership Team and see what they can do to help parents be more in the know.

 - *Mrs. Peery distributed a copy of the current 2022/2023 School Improvement Plan including the trustland spending plan as a review. No questions were asked
- 6. Next month look at data and discuss school's greatest need for developing new SIP

 - *Tashelle shared that the money raised from the fundraiser will allow the PTA to donate \$4500 to the school to add to the \$3500 last year to help with the cost of the \$17,000 marquee. Mrs. Peery is going to see if she can expedite the installation of the marquee to be during this current school year rather than during the summer as one of the district summer projects.
